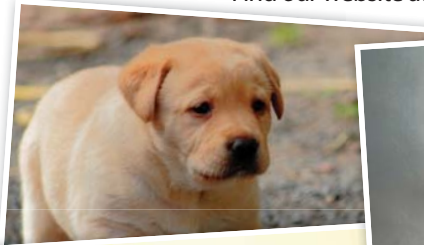

southern Europe and Asia

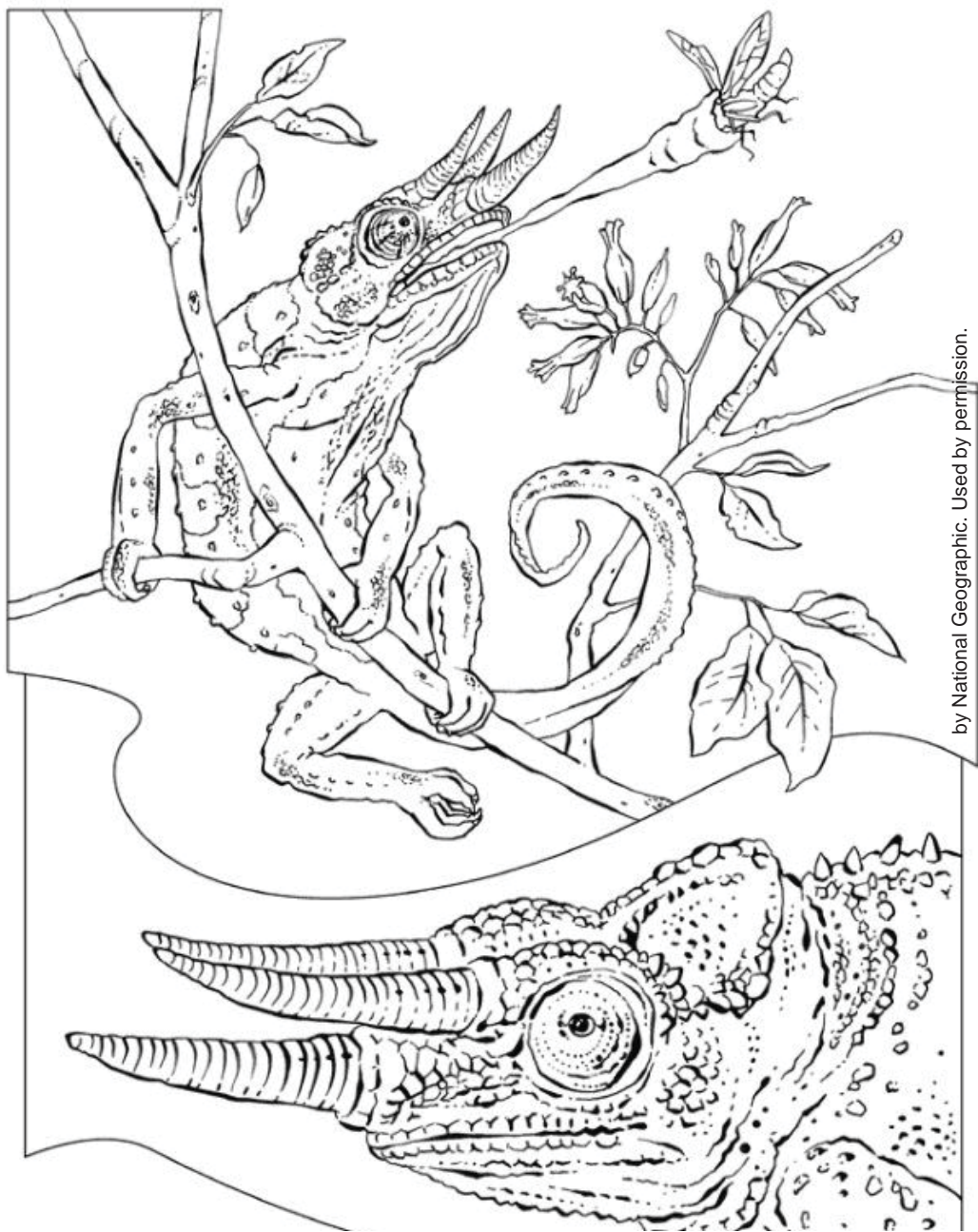
Eats: Locusts, mantids, crickets,

STICKY FACTS

- Half the chameleon population lives on the island of Madagascar.
- Chameleons can move their eyes independently. No other animal in the world can do that.
- Chameleons have very good eyesight for reptiles. They can see small insects 5-10 metres away.
- They have a prehensile tail. This term means that they can use their tail as another foot!
- Chameleons constantly change their color according to their emotions, light, and temperature.
- While chameleons are very slow, their tongues are very fast. Did you know that they can catch 4 flies in 3 seconds?

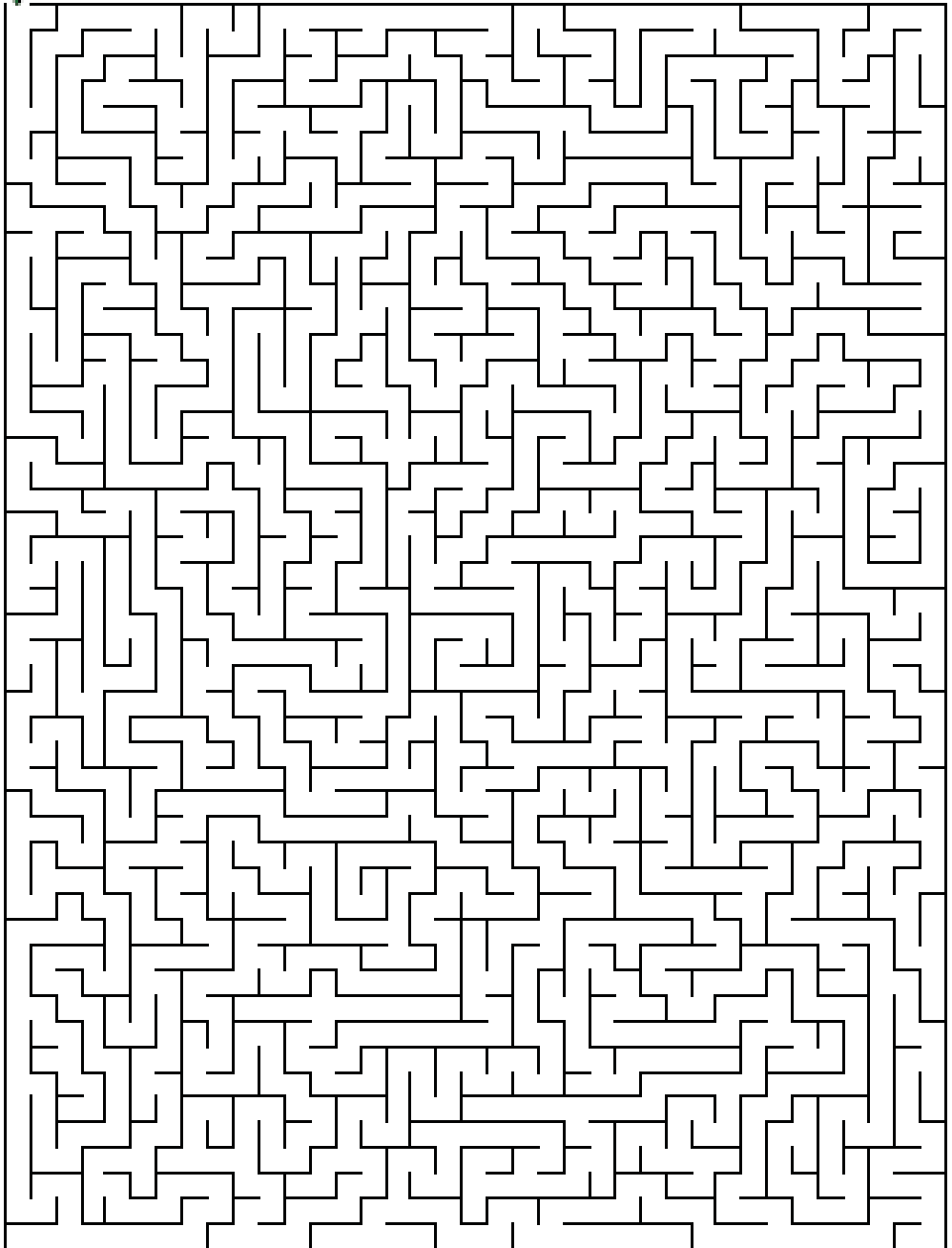

City on a Hill

Did you know that chameleons can change color? That's right. But did you know that chameleons don't actually change color to match their environment? That's a myth. Chameleons already match their environment; however, their body temperature and emotional status are the factors that cause the chameleon to change its colors. The warmer or angrier the chameleon is, the brighter its color becomes.

Chameleons conceal themselves best where they spend most of their time: in trees—making it much easier to hunt their prey, whether the prey is resting or in midflight

While chameleons don't actually change their colors to match their environment, someone who is called a chameleon, blends in with their surroundings.
